



Tico Tours Trinidad and Tobago: Summary

Trinidad and Tobago is a magical set of islands. They are very accessible and are both filled with a wide range of magnificent birds and are an ideal place for birders to visit – an excellent introduction to the Neotropical region. If the birds weren't enough, the food, landscapes and vibe on the islands are a joy to behold.

Of all of the Caribbean islands, Trinidad is the most bountifully blessed with birdlife with around 400 species recorded. The large number species recorded is a result of the great variety of habitats present, which range from open-ocean to tall mountains and from scrub-covered deserts to emerald rainforests. An abundance of perennially available fruits and seed provides foraging opportunities for resident and migrant species from both North and South America. Tobago also has a good range of species, several of which are not found on Trinidad. Tobago's seabirds are also highly sought as they contain some of the most spectacular and photogenic of the pelagic species.

The following are a selection of scheduled tours to Trinidad and Tobago, timed to coincide with an influx of migratory species from North America and South America. Customized tours can also be arranged for any duration, in any season, for any target species. In addition, tour extensions can be easily organised to extend your birding tour or to take in some of the many impressive beaches the country has to offer if you so wish.
